Adobe Spark allows you to create short, simple videos. A user can upload photos, videos, and logos. It has the ability to record narration, access free music tracks and photos. Adobe Spark does include their credit at the end of the video.



Pick a Template or Start from scratch

On Right of screen, Click on Themes to select a background, Click Music to add sound, Click Layout to change the slide layout.

Your slides appear at the bottom of the screen

To delete slides you do not need →
To add a narration to a slide, click the recording

button. 

 The play button to the left of your slides will show you what you have created so far.

The play button on the bottom corner of each slide will preview only that slide.

Click the X (top right) to go back to the creation screen.

Click Share, Pick a category (Education), Click Create link

Click download to save as an .mp4 file. The file will be placed in your download folder.
